



THE PRICE FREEZE REGULATIONS 1982, AMENDMENT NO. 8

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 25th day of July 1983

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Price Freeze Regulations 1982, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Price Freeze Regulations 1982* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Commencement and expiry—(1) These regulations shall come into force on the 29th day of July 1983.

(2) These regulations shall continue in force until the close of the 29th day of February 1984, and shall then expire.

3. Recovery of additional sum where fertiliser subsidy reduced—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 6, the following regulation:

“6A. Where the amount of the Government subsidy on the price of phosphate rock or fertiliser is reduced after the commencement of these

regulations, nothing in these regulations prevents the recovery in the price of phosphate rock or fertiliser of an amount which is on account of that reduction and which does not exceed the amount of that reduction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 29 July 1983, provide that where the amount of the Government subsidy on the price of phosphate rock or fertiliser is reduced after the commencement of the Price Freeze Regulations 1982, nothing in those regulations prevents the recovery in the price of phosphate rock or fertiliser of an amount which is on account of that reduction and which does not exceed the amount of that reduction.
