HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Price Freeze Regulations 1982, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Price Freeze Regulations 1982* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Commencement and expiry—(1) These regulations shall come into force on the 13th day of September 1983.

(2) These regulations shall continue in force until the close of the 29th day of February 1984, and shall then expire.

3. Exempted services—The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding, after clause 15 (as added by regulation 16 of the Price Freeze Regulations 1982, Amendment No. 7), the following clause:

“16. Servicing of mares by stallions.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 13 September 1983, exempt from the scope of the Price Freeze Regulations 1982 the servicing of mares by stallions.
