

## THE PRICE FREEZE REGULATIONS (NO. 2) 1973, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Price Freeze Regulations (No. 2) 1973, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Price Freeze Regulations (No. 2) 1973\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 9th day of April

1973.

2. Control of prices—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 3, and substituting the following regulation:
"3. (1) Notwithstanding anything in the Stabilisation of Prices Regu-

- "3. (1) Notwithstanding anything in the Stabilisation of Prices Regulations 1972, the maximum price that may be charged by any wholesaler or retailer for any fish shall be the normal price at which such fish was last lawfully sold by him in similar quantities and under similar conditions of purchase on or before the 21st day of March 1973.
- "(2) For the purposes of this regulation, fish shall be deemed to have been sold when possession of the fish has been taken by the purchaser

and not otherwise."

(2) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definition of the expression "sheep meat".

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations omit the provisions of the principal regulations relating to sheep meat, which will apply only to fish.

Price orders fixing maximum prices for sheep meat have been made and will come into force at the same time as these regulations.
