REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Amendment Regulations 1999, and are part of the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Regulations 1977* (“the principal regulations”).

(2) These regulations come into force on 1 April 1999.

2. Eighth Schedule amended—The Eighth Schedule of the principal regulations is amended—

- (a) By omitting from each of paragraphs (c), (d), (g), (i), (k), (l), (m), and (n) of item 4 the expression “58.45”, and substituting in each case the expression “78.45”; and
- (b) By omitting from paragraph (e) of item 4 the expression “54.00”, and substituting the expression “74.00”.
