PURSUANT to section 71 of the Private Investigators and Security Guards Act 1974, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Private Investigators and Security Guards Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Private Investigators and Security Guards Regulations 1975* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 8th day of October 1991.
- 2. New scale of fees substituted—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2

of the Private Investigators and Security Guards Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 3), and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

- **3. Goods and services tax included**—The fees prescribed by these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.
- **4. Revocations**—(1) The Private Investigators and Security Guards Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 3 are hereby revoked.
- (2) The Fees Regulations 1987* are hereby amended by revoking so much of the Schedule as relates to the Private Investigators and Security Guards Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 2.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 8 October 1991, prescribe a new scale of fees in respect of various matters under the Private Investigators and Security Guards Act 1974.

The fees prescribed are inclusive of goods and services tax.
