# Notice

## 1 Title

This notice is the Penal Institutions (Fergusson Drive (Upper Hutt) Police Jail) Notice 2003.

## 2 Commencement

This notice takes effect from 11 September 2003.

# **3** Fergusson Drive (Upper Hutt) Police Jail

The land described in the Schedule is declared to be a police jail to be known as the Fergusson Drive (Upper Hutt) Police Jail.

# Fergusson Drive (Upper Hutt) Police Jail

The following parcels of land in the Wellington Land Registration District:

- (a) containing 1434 square metres, more or less, being part Lots 56, 57, and 58, Deposited Plan 1336, and being the balance of the land declared to be taken for a police station by notice published in the *Gazette* of 1965 at page 2015 and registered as *Gazette* Notice 653290:
- (b) containing 1434 square metres, more or less, being part Lots 59, 60, and 61, Deposited Plan 1336, and being the balance of the land declared to be taken for a police station by notice published in the *Gazette* of 1970 at page 2135 and registered as *Gazette* Notice 851766.
