THE PRIMARY INDUSTRIES EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 1.

GALWAY, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 13th day of December, 1939.

THE HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Primary Industries Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and form part of the Primary Industries Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 2. The principal regulations are amended by inserting therein, next following Regulation 7 thereof, the following additional regulations:—
- "7a. The Governor-General may appoint a fit person to be known as the Wool Liaison Officer and to hold office during his pleasure.
- "7B. The Wool Liaison Officer shall receive, out of moneys in any appropriate account established in the Reserve Bank in connection with the purchase of wool pursuant to the Marketing Department (Extension of Powers) Order 1939, such salary and travelling-allowance for personal expenses as may be approved by the Minister of Marketing.
- "7c. The functions of the Wool Liaison Officer shall be generally to assist the Minister and the Controller in carrying out the functions conferred on the Minister and the Controller by these regulations in so far as they relate to wool, to exercise any powers and functions delegated to him under Regulation 5 hereof, and to exercise such powers and functions in relation to the purchase of wool pursuant to the Marketing Department (Extension of Powers) Order 1939 as may be lawfully conferred on him."
