THE PENAL INSTITUTIONS NOTICE 1956

PURSUANT to the Penal Institutions Act 1954, the Minister of Justice hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Penal Institutions Notice 1956.
 2. The land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a prison, known as the Wi Tako Prison.
 3. This notice is in substitution for the Proclamation of Wi Tako Prison made on the 29th day of July 1954.*

SCHEDULE

WI TAKO PRISON

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District, situated in the Hutt County, containing 533 acres 2 roods and 8·1 perches, more or less, being parts of sections 100, 104, 105, 106, 108, and 206, Hutt District, Block I, Rimutaka Survey District, and being part of the land comprised in certificate of title, Volume 57, folio 4, Wellington Registry (S.O. Plans 17258 and 22625).

Also all that area in the Wellington Land District, situated in the Hutt County, containing 300 acres, more or less, being parts of sections 104, 106, 107, 108, 109A, and 285, Hutt District, Block I, Rimutaka Survey District, and being part of the land comprised in certificate of title, Volume 57, folio 4, Wellington Registry, as shown on a plan marked J7/13/6 deposited in the Head Office of the Department of Justice at Wellington, and thereon edged red.
