THE PENAL INSTITUTIONS NOTICE 1959

PURSUANT to the Penal Institutions Act 1954, the Minister of Justice hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Penal Institutions Notice 1959.

2. The land described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a prison known as the Christchurch Prison.

3. (1) The land described in the Second Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be added to the prison known as the Paparua Prison, which was declared to be a prison by clause 6 of the Penal Institutions Notice 1955.*

(2) The Fifth Schedule to the Penal Institutions Notice 1955* is hereby amended by adding the words set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE
CHRISTCHURCH PRISON

ALL that area in the Canterbury Land District containing 3 roods 15 perches, more or less, being part Rural Section 38025, situated in Blocks XI and XV, Christchurch Survey District, City of Christchurch, as the same is delineated on plan marked J5/3/23 deposited in the Head Office of the Department of Justice, Wellington, and thereon coloured red.

SECOND SCHEDULE
LAND ADDED TO PAPARUA PRISON

ALSO all that area in the Canterbury Land District containing 81 acres and 22 perches, more or less, being Section 2, Drayton Settlement, situated in Block XII, Rolleston Survey District, Canterbury R.D. (edged red on P.W.D. Plan 158056).

SECOND SCHEDULE—*continued*

Also all that area in the Canterbury Land District containing 68 acres and 26 perches, more or less, being part Section 1, Drayton Settlement, situated in Block XII, Rolleston Survey District, Canterbury R.D. (edged red on P.W.D. Plan 158056). As the same are delineated on plan marked J5/3/14 deposited in the Head Office of the Department of Justice, Wellington, and thereon edged red.
