THE PENAL INSTITUTIONS NOTICE (NO. 3) 1959

PURSUANT to the Penal Institutions Act 1954, the Minister of Justice hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Penal Institutions Notice (No. 3) 1959.

PART I

2. The land described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a prison known as the Christchurch Prison.

3. This Part of the notice is in substitution for the notice last mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto and the specified parts of the other notices mentioned in that Schedule, and the notice last mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto and the said specified parts are hereby revoked.

PART II

4. The police stations at the following places, namely, the Chatham Islands, Gisborne, Kaikohe, Kaitaia, Nelson, Opotiki, Rotorua, Thames, Wairoa, and Whakatane are hereby declared to be police jails.

5. This Part of this notice is in substitution for the Proclamations and notices relating to police jails which are specified in the Third Schedule hereto and for every other former Proclamation or notice that declares any land or building to be a police jail, and all such notices are hereby revoked.

SCHEDULES

FIRST SCHEDULE

CHRISTCHURCH PRISON

ALL that area in the Canterbury Land District, in the Papanui County, containing 1,390 acres 1 rood 31 perches, more or less, being Sections 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, and 13, and part of Section 6, Drayton Settlement, Reserve 2531, parts of Reserve 702, and Rural Section 36831, and part of Rural Section 4886, situated in Block XII, Rolleston Survey District, and Block IX, Christchurch Survey District, bounded as follows:

FIRST SCHEDULE—*continued*

Commencing at the north-eastern corner of Reserve 325 in Block XII, Rolleston Survey District, and bounded towards the north generally by West Coast Road, 2968·4 links and 764·6 links, Reserve 2530, again by West Coast Road, 100 links, part Reserve 702 comprised in certificate of title, Volume 343, folio 30, Lot 3, Deposited Plan 3415, and Lots 1 and 2, Deposited Plan 7627; towards the south-east by Haskett Road; towards the south generally by a public road forming the northern boundaries of Lots 2 and 1, Deposited Plan 16841, and Reserve 3962; towards the north-east by Reserve 3962 and Barter Road; towards the south-east by Sections 20 to 16 (inclusive), Drayton Settlement; towards the south-west generally by Sections 15, 14, and 12 to 9 (inclusive), Drayton Settlement; again towards the south-east by Section 9 aforesaid; again towards the south-west by Church Road; again towards the south-east by Newton Road; again towards the south-west by part Rural Section 5721, and Rural Sections 8913 and 7715, comprised in certificate of title, Volume 177, folio 147, and Rural Section 7467; towards the north-west by Sections 1 and 2, Drayton Settlement; and towards the west generally by Church Road, Section 2 aforesaid, and Reserve 325; excepting thereout portion of Church Road and another public road intersecting the above-described area.

Also all that area in the Canterbury Land District containing 81 acres and 22 perches, more or less, being Section 2, Drayton Settlement, situated in Block XII, Rolleston Survey District, Canterbury R.D. (edged red on P.W.D. Plan 158056).

Also all that area in the Canterbury Land District containing 68 acres and 26 perches, more or less, being part Section 1, Drayton Settlement, situated in Block XII, Rolleston Survey District, Canterbury R.D. (edged red on P.W.D. Plan 158056); as the two areas last mentioned are delineated on plan marked J. 5/3/14 deposited in the Head Office of the Department of Justice, Wellington, and thereon edged red.

Also all that area in the Canterbury Land District containing 3 roods 15 perches, more or less, being part Rural Section 38025, situated in Blocks XI and XV, Christchurch Survey District, City of Christchurch; as the same is delineated on plan marked J. 5/3/14 (Christchurch) deposited in the Head Office of the Department of Justice, Wellington, and thereon coloured red.

Also all that area in the Canterbury Land District containing 5 acres and 19·6 perches, more or less, being part of Reserve 1636, situated in Block II, Leeston Survey District; as the same is delineated on the plan marked J. 5/3/14 (Rolleston) deposited in the Head Office of the Department of Justice, Wellington, and thereon bordered red. (S.O. Plan 9396.)
