NOTICE

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Penal Institutions (Dunedin Prison) Notice 1998.

(2) This notice comes into force on 5 June 1998.

**2. Dunedin Prison**—The land described in the Schedule is declared to be a prison, to be known as Dunedin Prison.

**3. Revocations**—The following notice and parts of a notice are revoked:

(a) The Penal Institutions Notice 1974\*:

(b) Clause 4 of the Penal Institutions Notice 1984† and so much of the Schedule of that notice as relates to the parts of the building thirdly described in that schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This notice, which comes into force on 5 June 1998, is made under the Penal Institutions Act 1954. It declares the land described in the Schedule to be a prison, to be known as Dunedin Prison. This notice replaces previous notices relating to Dunedin Prison and Dunedin Youth Prison.

This notice updates and consolidates the legal description of Dunedin Prison.
