NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Penal Institutions (Christchurch Prison) Notice 1998.

(2) This notice comes into force on 5 June 1998.

2. Christchurch Prison—The land and parts of the building described in the Schedule are declared to be a prison, to be known as Christchurch Prison.

3. Revocations—The following notices and parts of notices are revoked:

CHRISTCHURCH PRISON

All that parcel of land in the Canterbury Land District containing 2.1817 hectares, or thereabouts, being Rural Section 38025, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title No. 36A/28, Canterbury Registry; and

All that parcel of land in the Canterbury Land District containing 530 square metres, or thereabouts, being Rural Section 40181, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title No. 37B/1145, Canterbury Registry; and

All that parcel of land in the Canterbury Land District containing 1066 square metres, or thereabouts, being Part Reserve 3889, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title No. 37B/1146, Canterbury Registry; and

All that parcel of land in the Canterbury Land District containing 619 square metres, or thereabouts, being Reserve 3788, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title No. 37B/1153, Canterbury Registry; and

All that parcel of land in the Canterbury Land District containing 224.31 hectares, or thereabouts, being Section 1 on Survey Office Plan 19454, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title No. 41A/138, Canterbury Registry; and

All that parcel of land in the Canterbury Land District containing 220.73 hectares, or thereabouts, being Section 2 on Survey Office Plan 19454, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title No. 41A/139, Canterbury Registry; and

All that parcel of land in the Canterbury Land District containing 185.29 hectares, or thereabouts, being Section 3 on Survey Office Plan 19454, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title No. 41A/140, Canterbury Registry; and

All that parcel of land in the Canterbury Land District containing 176.13 hectares, or thereabouts, being Section 4 on Survey Office Plan 19454, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title No. 41A/141, Canterbury Registry; and

The cell blocks contained within the building complex known as the Christchurch Courthouse, containing the High Court and District Court, situated on—

- (b) All that parcel of land in the Canterbury Land District containing 5078 square metres, or thereabouts, being Section 1 on Survey Office Plan 11619, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title No. 36B/317, Canterbury Registry.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 5 June 1998, is made under the Penal Institutions Act 1954. It declares the land and parts of the building described in the Schedule to be a prison, to be known as Christchurch Prison. The parts of the building described in the Schedule are the cell blocks at the Christchurch Courthouse (containing the High Court and the District Court). This notice replaces previous notices relating to Christchurch Prison and Christchurch Borstal Institution.

This notice updates and consolidates the legal description of Christchurch Prison.
