THE POTATO-GROWING INDUSTRY REGULATIONS 1951,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1

COBHAM, Governor-General  
ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 25th day of May 1959

THE RIGHT HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Potato-Growing Industry Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Potato-Growing Industry Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Potato-Growing Industry Regulations 1951\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the definition of the term "levy" the words "and to a resolution of the Board published in the *Gazette* of the 15th day of February 1951", and substituting the words "and to any resolution of the Board under that section".

3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 3, and substituting the following regulation:

"3. These regulations apply to main-crop potatoes, in respect of which a levy is payable, grown in any part of New Zealand."

4. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 6, the following regulations:

"6A. (1) Every grower who claims that any potatoes sold by him are not potatoes in respect of which a levy is payable shall, within seven days after being requested to do so by the Board or by an officer of the Board authorised in that behalf, make and sign a statement to the effect that the potatoes are not subject to a levy and setting out the grounds of his claim.

"(2) Every person who refuses to make and sign a statement or who wilfully makes a false or misleading statement under this regulation commits an offence against these regulations.

“6B. Every person who purchases any main-crop potatoes from a grower shall, on demand by the Board or an authorised officer of the Board, disclose to the Board or its authorised officer the name of the grower and the quantity of potatoes purchased from him.”

5. Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is hereby revoked.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations provide measures enabling the Potato Board to obtain information necessary for the enforcement of the payment of the levy payable under the Potato-Growing Industry Act 1950. They also provide that the levy shall be payable on all main-crop potatoes grown in New Zealand.
