PURSUANT to the Penal Institutions Act 1954, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Penal Institutions Regulations 1961, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Penal Institutions Regulations 1961\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 68.

3. Regulation 92 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "On the recommendation of the Superintendent, with the approval of the Secretary", and substituting the words "With the approval of the Secretary or the Superintendent".

4. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 93, and substituting the following regulation:

"93. The Secretary or the Superintendent may approve any expenditure by an inmate from the earnings previously credited or subsequently to be credited to him."

5. Regulation 94 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the word "Secretary", the words "or the Superintendent".

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations amend the Penal Institutions Regulations 1961.

Regulation 2 revokes the regulation which requires female inmates to be at all times in the charge of female officers.

Regulations 3, 4, and 5 make amendments which have the effect of conferring on Superintendents certain powers in respect of the earnings of inmates which can at present only be exercised by, or with the approval of, the Secretary for Justice.
