Explanatory note

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which takes effect from 19 December 2001, is made under the Penal Institutions Act 1954. It declares the land described in the *Schedule* to be a police jail, to be known as North Street (Timaru) Police Jail. The land is at North Street in Timaru. It is used for the purposes of, and has on it 1 or more buildings known as, the Timaru Police Station.

This notice revokes and replaces part of a previous notice that declared the Timaru Police Station to be a police jail.
