All that parcel of land in the Wellington Land District containing 4053 square metres, more or less, situated in Block IX, Westmere Survey District, being Section 541, Town of Wanganui, and being the land declared to be set apart for police purposes by notice published in the *Gazette* of 1985 at page 2245 and registered as *Gazette* Notice 696408.1.
