Notice

1 Title

This notice is the Penal Institutions (Logan Street (Tokoroa) Police Jail) Notice 2003.

2 Commencement

This notice takes effect from 10 July 2003.

3 Logan Street (Tokoroa) Police Jail

The land described in the Schedule is declared to be a police jail to be known as the Logan Street (Tokoroa) Police Jail.

4 Revocation

The Penal Institutions (Police Jail) Notice 1990 (SR 1990/145) is revoked.

cl 3 Schedule Logan Street (Tokoroa) Police Jail

The following parcels of land in the South Auckland Land Registration District:

- (a) containing 2410 square metres, more or less, being Section 71, Block VIII, Patetere South Survey District, and being all the land declared to be set apart for a police station by notice published in the *Gazette* of 1967 at page 1270 and registered as *Gazette* Notice S383206:
- (b) containing 1004 square metres, more or less, being part Section 70, Block VIII, Patetere South Survey District, and being all the land declared to be set apart for a police station by notice published in the *Gazette* of 1974 at page 1023 and registered as *Gazette* Notice S662170.
