THE PRIVATE LINES (ELECTRICITY CORPORATION OF NEW ZEALAND LIMITED) EXEMPTION ORDER 1987

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 30th day of March 1987

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Post Office Act 1959, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Private Lines (Electricity Corporation of New Zealand Limited) Exemption Order 1987.

2. Commencement and expiry—(1) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1987.

(2) This order shall continue in force until the close of the 31st day of December 1987, and shall then expire.

3. Certain lines exempt from licensing requirements—Lines erected, constructed, maintained, or used for communication purposes by

Electricity Corporation of New Zealand Limited are hereby specified to be lines to which subsections (1) and (2) of section 159 of the Post Office Act 1959 shall not apply.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 April 1987, and remains in force until the close of 31 December 1987 is made pursuant to section 159 (3) (c) of the Post Office Act 1959 (as inserted by clause 39 of the Fourth Schedule to the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986) and exempts lines (as defined in section 141 of the Post Office Act 1959) erected, constructed, maintained, or used for communication purposes by the Electricity Corporation of New Zealand Limited from the operation of subsections (1) and (2) of section 159 of the Post Office Act 1959.
