



**THE POSITIVE LIST OF CONTROLLED GOODS AND
SERVICES 1977, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

PURSUANT to subsections (6) and (7) of section 82 of the Commerce Act 1975, the Minister of Trade and Industry, after reference of the subject-matter of this notice to the Commerce Commission for inquiry and report and after receiving the report of that Commission, hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1977, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Controlled goods and services—The First Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting from the part headed *Building Materials* the items “Timber (New Zealand grown)” and “Timber charges”, and substituting the following items:

“Timber (New Zealand grown exotic).

“Timber services performed in relation to New Zealand grown exotic timber or timber imported into New Zealand:

- Dressing.
- Drying, air or kiln.
- Measuring and gauging.
- Processing.
- Preservative treatment.
- Sawing.
- Selecting.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The notice exempts from price control indigenous timber and indigenous timber services. Exotic timber grown in New Zealand, and timber services performed in relation to exotic timber grown in New Zealand or timber imported into New Zealand remain subject to price control.

This notice is based upon recommendations made by the Commerce Commission to the Minister of Trade and Industry following an inquiry held by the Commission pursuant to section 82 (7) of the Commerce Act 1975.
