

THE POSITIVE LIST OF CONTROLLED GOODS AND SERVICES 1977, AMENDMENT NO. 5

PURSUANT to section 82 (6) of the Commerce Act 1975, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1977, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).
- (2) This notice shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Controlled goods and services—The First Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting from the part headed "Hardware" the item beginning with the words "Metals, ferrous and non-ferrous,", and substituting the following items:
 - "Metals and metal alloys, ferrous and non-ferrous, in the form of bar, billet, block, foil, ingot, rod, section, sheet, strip, or tube, or in any primary or intermediary form, but excluding—
 - "(a) All aluminium and aluminium alloys; and
 - "(b) Extruded brass rod.
 - "Aluminium in the form of foil or sheet and aluminium alloys in either of those forms."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice restates the description of the metals that are subject to price control.

The principal change is that primary aluminium and aluminium alloys (with 2 exceptions) are exempted from price control. The 2 exceptions (which remain subject to price control) are aluminium in the form of foil or sheet and aluminium alloys in either of those forms.
