



THE POSITIVE LIST OF CONTROLLED GOODS AND
SERVICES 1977, AMENDMENT NO. 4

PURSUANT to section 82 (6) of the Commerce Act 1975, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1977, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1980.

2. Controlled goods and services—The First Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting from the part headed "*Foodstuffs and Related Commodities*" the item "Butter, manufactured in New Zealand, excluding butter when sold in portions not exceeding 30 g", and substituting the following item:

"Butter, manufactured in New Zealand, except when sold—

"(a) Ex factory; or

"(b) In portions not exceeding 30 g".
