**THE POSITIVE LIST OF CONTROLLED GOODS AND SERVICES
1981, AMENDMENT NO. 11**

PURSUANT to section 82 of the Commerce Act 1975, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1981, Amendment No. 11, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1981* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 4th day of April 1985.

2. Controlled goods and services—The First Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting item No. 26 (an item relating to lead, in the form of sheet or strip) and item No. 27 (an item relating to lead alloys, in the form of sheet or strip).
