THE POSITIVE LIST OF CONTROLLED GOODS AND SERVICES 1981, AMENDMENT NO. 6

Pursuant to section 82 of the Commerce Act 1975, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1981, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1981* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).
 - (2) This notice shall come into force on the 21st day of May 1982.
- **2. Controlled goods and services**—The First Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting items Nos. 15 to 17, and substituting the following item:
- "15. Neutral spirit made or distilled by the holder of a spiritmaker's licence under the Distillation Act 1971, when sold by the holder of that licence for the manufacture of alcoholic beverages."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, subject to one exception, exempts from price control those items of intoxicating liquor that are, immediately before the coming into force of this notice, subject to price control.

to price control.

The exception relates to neutral spirit. Neutral spirit made or distilled in New Zealand by the holder of a spiritmaker's licence under the Distillation Act 1971 remains subject to price control, when sold by the maker or distiller for the manufacture of alcoholic beverages.

This notice comes into force on 21 May 1982.
