



**THE POSITIVE LIST OF CONTROLLED GOODS AND SERVICES
1981, AMENDMENT NO. 12**

PURSUANT to section 82 of the Commerce Act 1975, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1981, Amendment No. 12, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1981* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1985.

2. Controlled Goods and Services—The First Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting—

- (a) Item No. 5 (an item relating to blood and bone, dried blood, and bone dust); and
- (b) Item No. 7 (an item relating to inorganic fertilisers and fertiliser mixtures containing inorganic ingredients); and
- (c) Item No. 8 (an item relating to urea).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 1 July 1985, exempts from price control—

- (a) Blood and bone, dried blood, and bone dust when sold at retail in quantities of 50 kg or more;
- (b) Inorganic fertilisers and fertiliser mixtures containing inorganic ingredients when sold at retail in quantities of 50 kg or more or of 45 litres or more in the case of liquids;
- (c) Urea when sold at retail in quantities of 50 kg or more.
