**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At Wellington this 14th day of August 1995

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 209 of the Sale of Liquor Act 1989, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Porirua Licensing Trust Order 1955, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed a part of the Porirua Licensing Trust Order 1955\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Elective members of Trust**—The Trust shall hereafter consist of 8 elective members, of whom—

- (a) Five shall be elected for Ward 1:
- (b) Two shall be elected for Ward 2:
- (c) One shall be elected for Ward 3.

**3. Revocation**—Clause 3 of the Porirua Licensing Trust Order 1955, Amendment No. 1 is hereby consequentially revoked.

This order reduces by 1 the number of elective members on the Porirua Licensing Trust by reducing from 6 to 5 the number of elective members for Ward 1.
