



**THE PIG MARKETING EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1943,
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Pig Marketing Emergency Regulations 1943, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Pig Marketing Emergency Regulations 1943* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definitions of the terms "Baconer", "Chopper", and "Overweight baconer" in subclause (1), and substituting the following definitions:—

" 'Baconer' means a pig (not being a pig graded as a chopper) which when killed and dressed will have a dressed weight (including the head) of more than 120 lb. and not more than 175 lb.; and includes the carcass of any such pig: "

" 'Chopper' means a pig which when killed and dressed will have a dressed weight (including the head) of more than 200 lb., or any other pig which is graded as a chopper; and includes the carcass of any such pig: "

" 'Overweight baconer' means a pig (not being a pig graded as a chopper) which when killed and dressed will have a dressed weight (including the head) of more than 175 lb. and not more than 200 lb.; and includes the carcass of any such pig: "

(2) Subclause (1) of Regulation 2 of the Pig Marketing Emergency Regulations 1943, Amendment No. 2, is hereby revoked.
