**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

Present :

THE RIGHT HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL!

PURSUANT to section 72 of the Police Offences Act, 1927, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Police Offences (Wrestling Contest) Regulations 1931, Amendment No. 4.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Police Offences (Wrestling Contest) Regulations 1931\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.

4. Clause 9 of the principal regulations, as substituted by the Police Offences (Wrestling Contest) Regulations 1931, Amendment No. 3, is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (h) thereof, and substituting the following paragraph :—

“(h) That in no contest other than one between professional wrestlers shall the time occupied in actual wrestling exceed fifteen minutes. If after six minutes’ wrestling neither of the wrestlers has a definite lead, the referee shall interrupt the bout, and after a break he shall, in agreement with the majority of the judges, order that the contest continue for a further period not exceeding nine minutes, with such breaks as he may order.”

5. The Police Offences (Wrestling Contest) Regulations 1931, Amendment No. 3, are hereby revoked.
