ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 21st day of April, 1938.

THE RIGHT HON. M. J. SAVAGE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Payment of Jurors Act, 1919, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Payment of Jurors Regulations 1938.
- 2. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of May, 1938.
- 3. The rates of fees and allowances to be payable to jurors for their attendance at any sitting of the Supreme Court, or at any inquest held before a Coroner, shall be as set out in the Schedule hereto.
- 4. The regulations made under the Payment of Jurors Act, 1919, on the 4th day of March, 1936,* are hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE.

RATES OF FEES.

COMMON jurors attending any civil or criminal sitting of the Supreme Court, or any juror attending a Coroner's inquest—

For attendance for a period exceeding three hours on any one day For attendance for a period not exceeding three hours on any one $\begin{pmatrix} \pounds & s. & d. \\ 0 & 13 & 4 \end{pmatrix}$

Expenses of Locomotion.

In addition to the fees prescribed, jurors residing beyond three miles from the Courthouse, or, in the case of an inquest, from the Courthouse or other place at which the inquest is held, shall receive a refund of the actual expenses reasonably incurred in travelling by public conveyance in attending such sittings or inquest. Receipts must be furnished for fares over 5s. other than railway fares. When there is no public conveyance, such jurors shall be allowed a mileage allowance at the rate of $4\frac{1}{2}d$. per mile.
