



PRICE ORDER NO. 108

In pursuance of the powers conferred on it by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939,* and acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following Price Order:—

1. This Price Order may be cited as Price Order No. 108.
2. Price Order No. 21† is hereby revoked.
3. The revocation of the said Price Order shall not affect the liability of any person for any offence in relation thereto committed before the date of this Order.
4. (1) Where any galvanized wire of the gauge and kind specified in the Schedule hereto is sold at Auckland, Wellington, Lyttelton, or Dunedin the maximum price shall be the appropriate price fixed in the said Schedule according to whether the sale is to a retailer (which term shall for the purposes of this Order include a manufacturer of wire products) or to a user.

(2) Where any such galvanized wire is sold elsewhere than at one of the places mentioned in the Schedule hereto the maximum price shall be the appropriate price fixed in the said Schedule increased by the cost of freight between the place of sale and such one of the said places as is nearest or most convenient of access to the place of sale:

Provided that the amount added to the price in respect of freight shall not in any case exceed the amount that would be chargeable if delivery between the said places had been effected at current rates by a common carrier.
