PRICE ORDER NO. 113

PURSUANT to the powers conferred on it by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939, the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following Price Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 113.
- 2. (1) Subject to the provisions of subclause (2) hereof, the maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer of 42 in. woolpacks shall be—
 - (a) For woolpacks sold at Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, and Dunedin, 7s. each:
 - (b) For woolpacks sold elsewhere in New Zealand, 7s. each, increased to the nearest halfpenny by a proportionate part of the freight charges incurred by the retailer in obtaining delivery at his store.
- (2) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the foregoing provisions of this clause, the retail price of 42 in. woolpacks shall not in any case exceed 7s. 3d. each.
