## PRICE ORDER NO. 120

PURSUANT to the powers conferred on it by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939,\* the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following Price Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 120, and shall come into force on the 21st day of December, 1942.

2. (1) Price Order No. 107† is hereby revoked.

(2) The revocation of the said Price Order shall not affect the liability of any person for any offence in relation thereto committed before the coming into force of this Order.

3. The maximum price at which ordinary household candles made in New Zealand may be sold by way of retail in any area within which a wholesale general merchant undertakes the free delivery of candles to retailers shall be 1s. 5d. per 1 lb. packet of six candles.

4. The maximum price at which such candles may be sold by way of retail at any other place in New Zealand shall be 1s. 5½d. per 1 lb. packet of six candles.

5. The maximum price at which such candles may be sold by way of retail at any place in New Zealand when sold in less than 1 lb. packet lots shall be 3d. per candle.
