



PRICE ORDER NO. 122 (APPLES)

PURSUANT to the powers conferred on it by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939,* the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following Price Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 122.

2. (1) Price Order No. 115† is hereby revoked.

(2) The revocation of the said Price Order shall not affect the liability of any person for any offence in relation thereto committed before the coming into force of this Order.

APPLICATION OF THIS ORDER.

3. This Order applies only with respect to apples grown in New Zealand.

FIXING MAXIMUM PRICES OF APPLES TO WHICH THIS ORDER APPLIES.

4. The maximum price that may be charged or received by any vendor (other than a retailer) for any apples to which this Order applies shall be 13s. 6d. a standard case (as prescribed by the New Zealand-grown Fruit Regulations 1940‡).

5. (1) The maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer for any apples to which this Order applies shall be 6d. a pound.

(2) Where the quantity of apples sold by a retailer in any one transaction is not an exact number of pounds, the maximum price shall be computed at the rate per pound fixed in accordance with the last preceding subclause:

Provided that if the price computed as aforesaid is not an exact number of pence or halfpence, the maximum price shall be computed to the nearest upward halfpenny.

(3) The provisions of this clause shall apply notwithstanding that any apples to which it relates may be sold otherwise than by weight.
