**PRICE ORDER NO. 13.**

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon the Price Tribunal by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939,\* and with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following Price Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 13.
2. The maximum price at which wooden safety matches of any brand or description and contained in boxes designed to hold up to approximately sixty matches may be sold by way of retail at any place in New Zealand, when sold in less than the customary packet lots, shall be not more than 1d. per box.
