PRICE ORDER NO. 15.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon the Price Tribunal by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939, and with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following Price Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 15.
- 2. The maximum price at which bolts and nuts, nuts, and coach screws of whatever class or kind may be sold by way of retail at Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, or Dunedin shall be not more than the wholesale price increased by 35 per cent. of such price.
- 3. The maximum price at which such bolts and nuts, nuts, and coach screws may be sold by way of retail at places other than Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, and Dunedin shall be not more than the wholesale price increased by 35 per cent. of such price and further increased by the actual or proportionate amount of any extra freight and/or carriage cost from warehouse into store paid by the retailer.
