PRICE ORDER NO. 21.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon the Price Tribunal by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939, and with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following Price Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 21.

2. The maximum prices at which American fencing-wire of the gauges and kinds set out in the Schedule hereto may be sold by way of retail at Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, and Dunedin shall be not more than the respective prices set out in the said Schedule under each such place and opposite each such gauge and kind.

3. The maximum prices at which American fencing-wire of 8 gauge plain and 12 gauge barbed may be sold by way of retail at places other than Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, and Dunedin shall be not more than the prices of 39s. 6d. per hundredweight and 43s. per hundredweight respectively, increased by the actual or proportionate amount of any extra freight and/or carriage cost from warehouse into store paid by the retailer.
