## PRICE ORDER NO. 23.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon the Price Tribunal by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939, and with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following Price Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 23.
2. The maximum price at which  $\frac{1}{8}$  in. Masonite Presdwood and  $\frac{1}{2}$  in. Cane-ite insulating board may be sold at Auckland, Wellington, Lyttelton, and Dunedin shall be not more than as follows:—
  - (a) When sold by an indent agent to a wholesaler 32s. per 100 square feet c.i.f.e. duty and sales tax paid.
  - (b) When sold by a wholesaler to a builder or a contractor 45s. per 100 square feet, less 10 per cent.
  - (c) When sold by a wholesaler in quantities not exceeding 10 sheets 45s. per 100 square feet.
  - (d) When sold by a wholesaler to a retailer or to another wholesaler 45s. per 100 square feet, less 15 per cent.
  - (e) When sold by a retailer .. 45s. per 100 square feet.

The prices calculated in accordance with (b), (c), (d), and (e) hereof to be subject to a discount of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent. if payment is made by the twentieth day of the month following month of sale.

3. The maximum price at which  $\frac{1}{8}$  in. Masonite Presdwood and  $\frac{1}{2}$  in. Cane-ite insulating board may be sold in other ports and inland districts shall be not more than the prices fixed in clause 2 hereof, increased by the actual or proportionate amount of extra freight and/or carriage costs.
