

PRICE ORDER NO. 46.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon the Price Tribunal by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939, and with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following Price Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 46.

2. The maximum prices at which and the conditions subject to which creamery butter, the standard quality of which is not lower than first grade, and whey butter may be sold in New Zealand by way of sale by retail shall be not more than as follows :—

- (1) In the case of creamery butter the standard quality of which is not lower than first grade, if sold by any retailer to whom a delivery of such butter by way of wholesale is available from any source whatsoever free of all freight charges, the price of 1s. 6d. per pound.
- (2) In the case of whey butter, if sold by any retailer to whom a delivery of such butter by way of wholesale is available from any source whatsoever free of all freight charges, the price of 1s. 5d. per pound.
- (3) In the case of creamery butter the standard quality of which is not lower than first grade and of whey butter, if sold by any retailer to whom a delivery of such creamery butter or whey butter by way of wholesale is not available free of all freight charges, a price not exceeding the appropriate maximum price per pound fixed for such creamery butter or whey butter pursuant to the foregoing provisions of this Order, increased by the actual or proportionate amount (calculated to the next highest halfpenny) of the freight charges incurred up to but not exceeding the charges that would have been incurred by the retailer if such butter had been obtained by way of wholesale by the retailer at the place from which such freight charges on such butter would have been the lowest.

**3.** For the purposes of this Order terms defined by the Butter Marketing Regulations 1937\* shall have the respective meanings assigned to them by the said regulations.

4. This Order shall come into force on the day following publication thereof in the *Gazette*.
