



PRICE ORDER NO. 64.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon the Price Tribunal by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939, and with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following Price Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 64.

2. The lines of chocolate and confectionery referred to in this Order include all assortments of chocolate tablets, filled blocks, enrober, and confectionery novelty lines manufactured in New Zealand and marketed by way of wholesale at a maximum price of—

(a) 4s. 2d. per box in trade "outers" of content, as follows:—

"Halfpenny" size units	144 units.
"Penny" size units	72 "
"Threepenny" size units	24 "
"Sixpenny" size units	12 "
"Shilling" size units	6 "

(b) In the case of $\frac{1}{4}$ lb. chocolate tablets and filled blocks, 4s. 2d. for "plain" and 4s. 8d. for "fancy" per trade box of 9 units; and

(c) In the case of $\frac{1}{2}$ lb. chocolate tablets and filled blocks, 5s. 6d. for "plain" and 6s. 2d. for "fancy" per trade box of 6 units.

In the case of both (b) and (c) the wholesale price varying *pro rata* with a greater or lesser trade box content; the term "plain" to include all assortments except those with "nut" and/or "almond" content.

3. The maximum price at which any such chocolate and confectionery may be sold by way of retail at any place in New Zealand shall be not more than as follows:—
