PRICE ORDER NO. 70

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon the Price Tribunal by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939,* and with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following Price Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 70.
- 2. The maximum price at which imitation crystallized cherries of any make or brand whatsoever may be sold at any place in New Zealand by a manufacturer, by a wholesale merchant, or by a retailer shall be not more than the respective price set out hereunder for each such type of sale:—
 - (a) When sold by a manufacturer to a wholesale merchant: The price of 1s. 3d. per pound.
 - (b) When sold by a wholesale merchant to a retailer: The price of 1s. 6d. per pound plus sales-tax.
 - (c) When sold by a retailer to a consumer: The price of 2s. 2d. per pound net.
