## PRICE ORDER NO. 75

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon the Price Tribunal by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939,\* and with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following Price Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 75.
- 2. Price Order No. 50† is hereby revoked.
- 3. The maximum price at which ordinary household candles made in New Zealand may be sold by way of retail at any place in New Zealand where a wholesale general merchant is situated shall be not more than 1s. 2d. per 1 lb. packet of six candles.
- 4. The maximum price at which such candles may be sold by way of retail at any other place in New Zealand shall be not more than 1s.  $2\frac{1}{2}d$ . per 1 lb. packet of six candles.
- 5. The maximum price at which such candles may be sold at any place in New Zealand by way of retail when sold in less than 1 lb. packet lots shall be not more than 2½d. per candle.
