PRICE ORDER NO. 75

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon the Price Tribunal by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939,* and with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following Price Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 75.
2. Price Order No. 50† is hereby revoked.
3. The maximum price at which ordinary household candles made in New Zealand may be sold by way of retail at any place in New Zealand where a wholesale general merchant is situated shall be not more than 1s. 2d. per 1 lb. packet of six candles.
4. The maximum price at which such candles may be sold by way of retail at any other place in New Zealand shall be not more than 1s. 2½d. per 1 lb. packet of six candles.
5. The maximum price at which such candles may be sold at any place in New Zealand by way of retail when sold in less than 1 lb. packet lots shall be not more than 2½d. per candle.
