## PRICE ORDER NO. 89

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon the Price Tribunal by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939,\* and with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following Price Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 89.

2. (1) Price Order No. 70† is hereby revoked.

(2) The revocation of the said Price Order shall not affect the liability of any person for any offence in relation thereto committed before the date of this Order.

3. The maximum price at which imitation crystallized cherries of any make or brand whatsoever may be sold at any place in New Zealand by a manufacturer, by a wholesale merchant, or by a retailer shall be not more than the respective price set out hereunder for each such type of sale:—

(a) When sold by a manufacturer to a wholesale merchant: The price of 1s. 3d. per pound.

(b) When sold by a wholesale merchant to a retailer: The price of 1s. 6d. per pound plus sales tax.

(c) When sold by a retailer to a consumer: The price of 2s. 4d. per pound net.
