## PRICE ORDER NO. 93

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon the Price Tribunal by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939,\* and with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following Price Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 93.

2. (1) Price Order No. 40† is hereby revoked.

(2) The revocation of the said Price Order shall not affect the liability of any person for any offence in relation thereto committed before the date of this Order.

3. In this Order :—

“Eggs” means the eggs of domestic fowls or ducks :

“Heavy grade”, “standard grade”, “medium grade”, and “pullet grade”, in relation to hen-eggs, mean the grades severally fixed pursuant to the Egg Marketing Regulations 1940‡ :

In the Auckland Egg-price Area—

The term “standard”, in relation to duck-eggs, means all such eggs the weight of which is not less than  $2\frac{7}{16}$  oz. ;

The term “medium”, in relation to duck-eggs, means all such eggs the weight of which is not less than  $2\frac{1}{16}$  oz. and not more than  $2\frac{6}{16}$  oz. ;

The term “small”, in relation to duck-eggs, means all such eggs the weight of which is less than  $2\frac{1}{16}$  oz. :

In the Wellington, Hawke’s Bay, Christchurch, Westland, and Dunedin Egg-price Areas—

The term “large”, in relation to duck-eggs, means all such eggs the weight of which is not less than  $2\frac{4}{16}$  oz. ;

The term “small”, in relation to duck-eggs, means all such eggs the weight of which is less than  $2\frac{1}{16}$  oz. ;

“Ungraded eggs”, in relation to hen-eggs, means eggs from which no eggs of heavy grade, standard grade, medium grade, or pullet grade have been selected since such eggs were gathered from a poultry-run, and, in relation to duck-eggs, means eggs from which no eggs of standard, large, medium, or small weight have been selected since such eggs were gathered from a poultry-run :

“Retailer” includes every person engaged in the sale by retail of eggs :

“Sale by wholesale” means a sale made to any person for the purpose of resale :

“Sale by retail” means a sale of eggs other than a sale by wholesale, and includes a sale made to any person for any purpose other than resale.

4. (1) This Order shall not apply to—

(a) Any sale of eggs for the purpose of hatching :

(b) Any sale of eggs by way of retail where delivery of the eggs is taken by the purchaser on the premises on which the eggs were produced.

(2) For the purpose of this clause the term “premises” does not include any premises on which any foodstuffs are customarily and regularly kept, exposed, or offered for sale by way of retail.

5. The maximum price at which eggs may be sold by way of wholesale in any of the egg-price areas defined in the First Schedule hereto shall be not more than the respective price set out in the Second Schedule hereto opposite each such egg-price area according to whether such eggs, being hen-eggs, are heavy grade, standard grade, medium grade, pullet grade, or ungraded, or, being duck-eggs, are of standard, large, medium, or small weight, or ungraded.

6. The maximum price at which eggs may be sold by way of retail in any of such egg-price areas shall be not more than the respective price set out in the Third Schedule hereto opposite each such egg-price area according to whether such eggs, being hen-eggs, are heavy grade, standard grade, medium grade, pullet grade, or ungraded, or, being duck-eggs, are of standard, large, medium, or small weight, or ungraded.

## SCHEDULES.

### FIRST SCHEDULE.

#### EGG-PRICE AREAS.

1. All that part of the North Island comprising the counties of Clifton, Whangamomona, Waitotara, Wanganui, Rangitikei, Kiwitea, Pohangina, Dannevirke, Weber, and south of a continuous line, including the boundaries of the said counties, together with that part of the South Island comprising the counties of Sounds, Collingwood, Takaka, Waimea, Marlborough, and Awatere, including all cities, boroughs, and town districts enclosed by the said counties or any of them (hereinafter referred to as the Wellington Egg-price Area).

2. All that part of the North Island comprising the counties of Patangata, Waipukurau, Waipawa, Hawke's Bay, and Wairoa, including all cities, boroughs, and town districts enclosed by the said counties or any of them (hereinafter referred to as the Hawke's Bay Egg-price Area).

3. All that part of the North Island not included in the Wellington and Hawke's Bay Egg-price Area (hereinafter referred to as the Auckland Egg-price Area).

4. All that part of the South Island comprising the counties of Kaikoura, Amuri, Cheviot, Waipara, Tawera, Ashley, Kowhai, Oxford, Rangiora, Eyre, Waimairi, Mount Herbert, Heathcote, Paparua, Akaroa, Wairewa, Halswell, Springs, Ellesmere, Malvern, Selwyn, Ashburton, Geraldine, Mackenzie, Levels, including all cities, boroughs, and town districts enclosed by the said counties or any of them (hereinafter referred to as the Christchurch Egg-price Area).

5. All that part of the South Island comprising the counties of Buller, Murchison, Inangahua, Grey, and Westland, including all cities, boroughs, and town districts enclosed by the said counties or any of them (hereinafter referred to as the Westland Egg-price Area).

6. All that part of the South Island not included in the Wellington, Christchurch, and Westland Egg-price Areas, together with Stewart Island (hereinafter referred to as the Dunedin Egg-price Area).
