**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 26th day of March 1979

THE RIGHT HON. R. D. MULDOON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Post Office Act 1959, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Inland Post) Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Post Office (Inland Post) Regulations 1977\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Inland postage rates and fees for other services**—(1) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking clause 15 (2) (c).

(2) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by revoking clause 16, and substituting the new clause 16 set out in the Schedule hereto.

## SCHEDULE

**16. Bulk mail rates**—The following postage is payable in respect of bulk mail postings, comprising 3,000 articles or more, which meet such conditions as may from time to time be notified by the Postmaster-General in the *Post Office Guide*:

## (1) General Postings—

(a) For standard letters presorted by the sender into:	District delivery order	Delivery office order	Street delivery order
10c for each letter .....	<i>less</i> 15 percent discount	<i>less</i> 20 percent discount	<i>less</i> 30 percent discount
(b) For other articles presorted by the sender into:	District delivery order	Delivery office order	Street delivery order
11c for each article weighing up to 100 g	} <i>less</i> 15 percent discount	} <i>less</i> 20 percent discount	} <i>less</i> 30 percent discount
14c for each article weighing over 100 g but not exceeding 250 g			
22c for each article weighing over 250 g but not exceeding 500 g			
34c for each article weighing over 500 g but not exceeding 1 kg			

## (2) Promotional postings—

As in subclause (1) above, less an additional 10 percent discount:  
Provided that in no case shall the total discount exceed 30 percent.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations prescribe new postage rates in respect of bulk mail and abolish the surcharge for airmail parcels sent to or from the Chatham Islands.
