THE POST OFFICE SAVINGS-BANK AMENDING REGULATIONS, 1937.

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.
Act pursuant to which the regulations were made : The Post and
Telegraph Act, 1928.

Date on which the regulations were made : 10th day of June, 1937.

Date of notification in *Gazette* : 24th day of June, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Post Office Savings-bank Amending Regulations, 1937.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and be deemed to form part of the Post Office Savings-bank Regulations, 1913,* made under the Post and Telegraph Act, 1908, and enuring under the Post and Telegraph Act, 1928 (hereinafter called "the principal regulations").

3. Clause (1) of Regulation 13 of the principal regulations (as enacted by the Post Office Savings-bank Amending Regulations, 1935†) is amended by revoking subclause (e) thereof—that is to say, all the words of the said clause (1) from "such other body" to "specifies"—and substituting the following subclause :—

"(e) Such other body or society or class of bodies or societies not carried on for purposes of trade or profit as the Postmaster-General shall approve."

4. Regulation 30 of the principal regulations (as enacted by the Post Office Savings-bank Amending Regulations, 1935) is amended by revoking clause (11) thereof, and substituting the following clause :—

"(11) The provisions of Regulation 32A hereof shall have no application to an account to which this regulation applies."

5. Regulation 32A of the principal regulations (as enacted by the Post Office Savings-bank Amending Regulations, 1934‡) is amended by inserting after the figure 11 in clause (6) thereof the following "or 13".
