ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 1st day of
August, 1945

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the powers conferred on him by section 4 of the Marketing Amendment Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

ORDER

1. This Order may be cited as the Purchase of Scheelite Order 1944, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Purchase of Scheelite Order 1944* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. Clause 3 of the principal Order is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (b), and substituting the following paragraph :—

“(b) All scheelite that is mined before the 1st day of July, 1945, and that is hereafter received into an approved store in accordance with the terms of this Order.”
