

# THE POST OFFICE STAFF REGULATIONS 1951, AMENDMENT NO. 19

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Post Office Act 1959, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

# REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Post Office Staff Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 19, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Post Office Staff Regulations 1951\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1964.
- 2. (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First, Second, and Third Schedules thereto (as substituted by regulation 7 of the Post Office Staff Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 18), and substituting the new Schedules set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- (2) Regulation 7 of the Post Office Staff Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 18, is hereby revoked.
