PURSUANT to section 4 of the Marketing Amendment Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

#### ORDER

1. This Order may be cited as the Purchase of Tallow Order 1940, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Purchase of Tallow Order 1940\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. (1) The principal Order is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule thereto (as enacted by the Purchase of Tallow Order 1940, Amendment No. 3), and substituting the following Schedule :---
