PURSUANT to section 4 of the Marketing Amendment Act 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Purchase of Tallow Order 1940, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Purchase of Tallow Order 1940* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. (1) The principal order is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule thereto (as enacted by the Purchase of Tallow Order 1940, Amendment No. 4), and substituting the following Schedule :—

(2) In addition to the rates set out in subclause (1) of this clause, there shall be paid a premium of £0·25 in United Kingdom currency for all tallow shipped in barrels.

3. (1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the principal order, payment at the rates prescribed in the Schedule to the principal order (as substituted by clause 2 of this order) shall be calculated on the net weight of tallow, less freight at the rate per ton on the gross weight of £6·275 in United Kingdom currency plus 15 per cent.

(2) Payment shall be made to the owner of the tallow in New Zealand currency upon the basis of £100 in United Kingdom currency to £100·325 in New Zealand currency.

4. (1) The Purchase of Tallow Order 1940, Amendment No. 4, is hereby revoked.

(2) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the foregoing provisions of this clause, the principal order, as heretofore amended, shall, with respect to tallow that has been manufactured before the 1st day of October 1951, be read as if this clause had not been enacted.
