HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Purchase of Wool Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Purchase of Wool Emergency Regulations 1939.\*

2. Regulation 8 of the Purchase of Wool Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1, is hereby amended by adding to subclause (3) the following proviso :—

“ Provided that in respect of all slipe wool delivered to wool-stores during the 1942-43 season a further payment of 1.29959 per cent. of each amount already paid in accordance with subclause (2) of this regulation shall first be made out of the amount of that excess.”
